





Wyoming Water Library


Staffed with a Water Librarian, this comprehensive collection of almost 21,000 documents is an exceptional resource for individuals desiring more in-depth information on the State's water resources. The collection includes a variety of government documents, maps, videos and water institute publications. Specific agencies and institutions represented in the collection include the Wyoming Water Development Commission, Wyoming State Engineer's Office, US Geological Survey, Bureau of Reclamation, Bureau of Land Management and University of Wyoming. Although all 50 states are represented in the Collection, our focus is Wyoming water. Other materials in the library cover drought, global climate change, the Wyoming State Water Plan Program, and environmental impacts. We also offer a water-specific reference collection.
